February 10th – Paint in the style of Andre Derain with Lyn Blake

Andre was a French artist, painter, sculptor and co-founder of Fauvism with Henri Matisse. Take a look at his work, then try his techniques to interpret an image of your choice in his bright and colourful style.

June 1st - Silk Painting with Angela Macpherson

This is a simple starter session to experiment with the medium. Angela will provide materials and designs to copy, or you can draw or bring your own. There will be a small added charge of £2.50 for materials.

September 14th - Experimental Watercolour with Christine Pascoe

January 25th - Tony Hogan – Seascape using Atelier Acrylics

Tony will demonstrate a new type of acrylics and will supply enough for all participants to use, just bring canvas, brushes etc.

February 22nd – Rebecca de Mendonca Light and atmosphere in the landscape.

Using pastels, Rebecca will demonstrate how to achieve light and atmosphere in your artwork.

March 28th – Anna Lopez Ventura

Drawing with perspective.

Anna will demonstrate techniques to observe and loosen up when drawing, plus trial new sketching materials, some of which you can take home. We will practice fun drawing techniques to gauge the shape of objects better to help achieve the picture you want.

May 16th - Celia Olsson – Creating

Texture in Watercolour

Celia will bring examples and demonstrate how to use texture making materials from your art box plus items from the kitchen cupboards and recycling bin to create texture in your paintings. We shall then use some of these techniques to work on a painting.

June 20th - Belinda Ireland – Flower Painting in Oils.

Belinda will demonstrate a 'wipe out' technique, colour mixing and more...

September 26th – Michael Hill - Harbour Scene in Acrylic

October 26th - Scott Russell Portraiture in Oils, with Model

Scott works on the process of seeing and sensing the subject, trying to eliminate conscious, intellectual thought, using a limited palette and a fast and furious approach.
