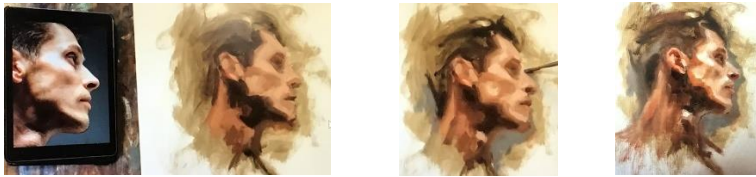


# Newsletter – May 2021
